

34. 24 hour retention barn subject to Woodbine Entertainment and AGCO protocols

35. All horses are subject to AGCO Out of Competition testing rules and protocols.

36. All post positions will be drawn by lot unless otherwise stated in the conditions.

37. Qualifying standards shall be governed by the Rules of Racing and the Regulations of the AGCO.

38. It is expressly acknowledged that officers and directors of Woodbine Entertainment are entitled to purchase entry slots in the Mohawk Million event and to negotiate a deal with a potential horse owner to race a horse in any such slot.

39. Entry of a horse shall constitute acceptance of these terms and conditions whether such entry is done in writing or electronically.

40. Each slot purchaser hereby expressly and irrevocably grants Woodbine Entertainment the exclusive right to use, in connection with the promotion of the Mohawk Million race, the name and likeness of the slot purchaser/horse owner, any horse pre-entered or entered and any co-owners, drivers, trainers, colors, logos, driving colours and any other associated or identifying characteristics as well as any other matter relating to the participation of the horse in the Mohawk Million race. Promotion by Woodbine Entertainment may include, without limitation, televising, broadcasting and/or recording in any manner the Mohawk Million race and the activities incidental to it, and broadcasting, exhibiting and/or exploiting the same by any means now hereafter known, including, without limitation, licensing such rights to others for uses approved by the slot purchaser. The slot purchaser, on behalf of himself and the horse owner, hereby expressly, irrevocably and perpetually waives on his behalf, on the horse owner's behalf and on behalf of his contractors, agents, and employees (including the trainers and drivers) any and all rights he or they may have in connection with any matter referred to in this paragraph, including, without limitation, any claim for invasion of the right of privacy or the right of publicity, for misappropriation, for infringement of trademark, trade dress and other intellectual property rights, or for any remuneration therefor. Upon demand, the slot purchaser/horse owner shall cause any of the aforementioned persons to deliver releases to slot purchaser and Woodbine Entertainment, permitting Woodbine Entertainment to use and exhibit such material. The slot purchaser/horse owner understands and agrees that Woodbine Entertainment reserves the right to use names, trademarks, service marks, copyrights, symbols, logos, slogans, results, still and motion pictures, audio reports, trailers, promos and other identifying characteristics in relation to the Mohawk Million race. Woodbine Entertainment reserves all rights to advertise the Mohawk Million race in any manner deemed appropriate by Woodbine Entertainment. Woodbine Entertainment grants to slot purchaser the right to use a sponsor of their horse if there is no conflict with any sponsor commitments that are obtained by Woodbine Entertainment for the Mohawk Million race or conflict with any sponsorship commitments or other assets or rights of Woodbine Entertainment and its affiliates subject to any limitations that exist with televising, broadcasting and/or recording in any manner the Mohawk Million race.

Cancellation:

The sponsors reserve the right to cancel any or all of the races if it becomes impractical or undesirable in the opinion of the sponsors to conduct said races. If an event is not raced, the sponsors responsibility and liability shall be limited to refunding, without interest, all payments collected toward these events. These monies will be pro-rated among those owners of horses eligible at the time of cancellation.

Added Money:

Sponsors will add a minimum of \$25,000 to this race. These funds, barring any unforeseen circumstance which may preclude this, in addition to all monies paid in by nominating horsemen, shall constitute the purses for this event. All entry fees will be added to the purse for this event.

Payments (in U.S. Funds only):

A nomination to each event requires payment as listed below. All payments are forfeits.

Supplemental Nomination/Declaration:

There shall be no supplemental nomination or declaration to this event.

Declaration:

Declarations will close at the time and date designated on the condition sheet of the Host Track. Declaration fees shall be due at the time of declaration and payable before the horse starts. Declaration fees should be made payable to the Host Track. There are no refunds for scratched horses.

At the time of declaration, horses declared to race in these events must have a past performance line that meets the current qualifying standard for stakes and/or added money races at the Host Track.

Notice:

Failure to make any payment required by the conditions constitutes an automatic withdrawal from the event.

Racing Conditions:

The number of starters will be limited to the 10 eligible and qualified fillies that are the highest money earners in 2020 from January 1st thru and including the official time of declaration on the Host Track's condition sheet.

In the event of more than 10 entries, eligible horses that are declared for any of these events but does not draw into the event due to the above condition (including a horses drawn as also eligible that does not draw into the race) and meets the track's qualifying standards for the race will have their nomination and sustaining fees refunded in full and shall not be liable for the entry fee.

The sponsors reserve the right to reject any entry and return the fees paid toward that entry. A minimum of six (6) separate wagering interests may be required in any event or the event may be cancelled. All starters are subject to the detention policy of the Host Track.

Money Division:

50-25-12-8-5% or USTA standard for less than five places for all races.

Disputes:

All owners, trainers and drivers of horses nominated to this event must be accepted to participate at each Host Track or the entry may be denied without refund of previous payments. Decisions by the Host Track shall govern all disputes arising from these conditions and their decision shall be final.

Rules:

A nomination to these events is an agreement to the above terms and conditions. The rules of the Host Track and its state Racing Commission along with the USTA shall govern unless otherwise specified in these conditions.

Nominated horses must be properly identified to the satisfaction of the Society at the time of nomination, including but not limited to certifying that the nominated horse is registered as a twin or is the only foal of the mare in 2017. The Society will not recognize foals as twins if produced through embryo/ovum transfer. If produced through embryo/ovum transfer, only the donor mare's first born foal in 2017 will be eligible for nomination. The Owner(s) of the nominated horse agree to indemnify and hold the Society and the Sponsors harmless from any and all claims, suits or damages, including attorney's fees, arising out of or related in any way to such certification.

To Be Raced As:

The Monument Circle for 3-Year-Old Colt & Gelding pacers

To Be Raced At:

Harrah's Hoosier Park, Anderson, Indiana. Definite date will be published in the USTA Stakes Guide in the year of the race. If for any reason it becomes impractical or undesirable, in the opinion of the Sponsors, to hold this race at the Host Track designated the Sponsors reserve the right to change the date and the location of the races.

Cancellation:

The Sponsors further reserve the right to cancel the race if for reasons beyond their control it becomes impractical or undesirable in the opinion of the Sponsors to conduct said race. If an event is not raced due to circumstances beyond their control, the Sponsors' responsibility and liability will be limited to refunding without interest nomination, sustaining and Entrance Fees collected toward canceled event that have not been disbursed at the time of cancellation. These monies will be prorated among the owners of the horses eligible as of the time of cancellation.

Added Money:

The Sponsors will add \$25,000 minimum to the race.

Payments (U.S. Funds only):
