**PENNSYLVANIA SIRE STAKES FUND
Race No. 52 (Fair Division)
Foals of 2016**

These events are subject to the Rules and Regulations of the Pennsylvania State Harness Racing Commission and the applicable rule of the Pennsylvania Department of Agriculture.

Each yearling must have been sired by a registered stallion standing in Pennsylvania the full season of service (2015) during which the dam was bred to produce such foal.

A copy of the USTA or other approved registration certificate is to accompany each nomination.

Each race is to be a mile dash.

Horses must show a charted line on the declared gait after May 15th with no breaks in the following time standards (with time allowances). Horses showing no such line in the past 45 days must qualify. Official workouts do not apply. Each trainer is responsible for knowing the conditions of eligibility of their horses.

2-Year-Old Trot.....	2:10
2-Year-Old Pace.....	2:06
3-Year-Old Trot.....	2:08
3-Year-Old Pace.....	2:04

The Judge or his designee shall decide if the field should be split for safety purposes. In the case of a split in the event, the association conducting same may divide the race by adopting one of the methods of division racing then current in the Pennsylvania State Harness Racing Commission Rules and Regulations. For purposes of cancellations the Judge's decision is final.

Gait must be declared by the March 15, 2018 payment. Transfer may be made at the time of declaration but starting payments remain in the respective funds.

All 2YO and 3YO starters must have 2 full days off between starts. Ex. Horse raced on Monday cannot race until Thursday

All 2-year-old and 3-year-old races will be raced in separate colt and filly divisions.

All starting fees will be added to the purse and will be paid to the track conducting the event. All other payments to Pennsylvania Sire Stakes Fund.

The Purses Will Be Distributed As Follows:

- 50-25-12-8-5% if 5 starters or more;
- 50-25-15-10% if 4 starters;
- 60-30-10% if 3 starters;
- 65-35% if only 2 starters;
- 100% in case of walkover.

Should circumstances prevent the racing of any event, all monies available will be prorated among horses declared in for the uncontested event at the time of declaring off; horses do not have to be on the grounds, but the entry fee must be paid before a check is released.

Points are awarded based on order of finish, in this manner: 35 points for first, 25 points for second, 15 points for third, 10 points for fourth, 8 points for fifth, 5 points for sixth, 4 points for seventh, 2 points for eighth, per the order of finish. A rain out will generate a horse 9 points and count as a start. A horse who is an official starter but does not finish of his or her own accord will get zero points. Scratches receive no points. DNFs receive no points but are credited with a start. In the case of a dead-heat for finish position, the points for that position and the one(s) under it will be added and divided by the number of horses in the dead-heat. The points are to be used to determine eligibility for any championship races that may be offered in that particular year; qualifying standards for such Fair Championships shall be those of the host track.

* Only points earned in Group A are eligible for the Fair Finals

* If you win 3 out of 4 starts In Group B you must move up to Group A

* Finishing 1st, 2nd or 3rd In Group A you must remain in Group A

Future Eligibility:

If a 2-year-old makes the required March 15 payment(s), they need not make the respective May 15 payment in order to be eligible at 3, but they are then ineligible at 2. Supplementary payment may be made to this stake on the foals of 2016 upon payment of \$250 between May 16 and December 31 of the yearling year, and \$500 between January 1 and March 15 of the 2-year-old year (plus the sustaining fees due on that date). To maintain eligibility all future payments may be made as regularly required. A \$750 late penalty payment may be made by February 15th of their 3- year-old season if the 1st 2-year-old Sustaining payment was not made plus the sustaining fees due on May 15th, 2019.

A \$750 late penalty payment may be made by February 15th of their 3-year-old season if the 1st 2-year-old Sustaining payment was not made plus the sustaining fees due on May 15th, 2020.

Each yearling must have been sired by a registered stallion standing in Pennsylvania the full season of service (2015) during which the dam was bred to produce such foal.

Each race is to be a mile dash.

A starter must show at least one clean charted line (no breaks) within 45 days prior to the advertised declaration date. No official workouts or non-regularly-scheduled qualifiers shall give a horse a satisfactory line. The time standard (subject to allowances) shall be the following:

3-Year-Old Pacers.....	2:00
3-Year-Old Trotters.....	2:02
2-Year-Old Pacers.....	2:03
2-Year-Old Trotters.....	2:05

There will be no trailers permitted to start in any Pennsylvania Sire Stakes races.

In the case of a split in the event, the association conducting same may divide the race by adopting one of the methods of division racing then current in the Pennsylvania State Harness Racing Commission Rules and Regulations.

Gait must be declared by the March 15, 2018 payment. Transfer may be made at the time of declaration but starting payments remain in the respective funds.

All 2-year-old and 3-year-old starters must have 4 full days off between starts. Ex. Horse raced on Monday, cannot race until Saturday.

All 2-year-old and 3-year-old races will be raced in separate colt and filly divisions.

Scratches receive no points. DNFs receive no points. In the case of a dead-heat for finish position, the points for that position and the one(s) under it will be added and divided by the number of horses in the dead-heat.

Fields for championship races will be limited to the number of starters allowed on the gate for each PA Pari-Mutuel Racetrack. Two AEs will be drawn in and programmed, and can scratch in until 6 p.m. the night before the race. If two or more horses are tied in the point standings and declare in for the championship, they shall be separated by the amount won in their pari-mutuel Sire Stakes

division. There is a \$1,000 starting fee for the Championship race.

Eligibility to the pari-mutuel Sire Stakes will also be used in determining eligibility for Stallion Series events that may be raced in any given year.

Future Eligibility:

Failure to make the March 15, 2018 2-year-old sustaining payment constitutes automatic elimination from this stake. If a 2-year-old makes the required March 15 payment(s), they need not make the respective May 15 payment in order to be eligible at 3, but they are then ineligible at 2.

Supplementary payment may be made to this stake on the foals of 2016 upon payment of \$750 between May 16 and December 31 of the yearling year, and \$1,500 between January 1 and March 15 of the 2-year-old year (plus the sustaining fees due on that date). To maintain eligibility all future payments may be made as regularly required.

Pennsylvania Sire Stakes Fund divided each year in accordance with the ratio established in the law.

To Be Raced At:

Dover Downs, Dover, Delaware ("Track"). Definite dates will be published in the USTA Stakes Guide in the year of the race. If for any reason it becomes impractical or undesirable, in the opinion of the Sponsor, to hold this race at the Track designated, the Sponsor reserves the right to change the date and/or the location of the Track for either any or all races.

Cancellation:

The Sponsor further reserves the right to cancel this race if for reasons beyond its control it becomes impractical or undesirable in the opinion of the Sponsor to conduct said race or races. If an event is not raced due to circumstances beyond its control, the Sponsor's responsibility and liability will be limited to refunding without interest nomination, sustaining and entrance fees collected toward canceled events that have not been disbursed at the time of cancellation. If canceled after the first 2-year-old payment, these monies will be prorated among the owners of the horses eligible at the time of cancellation. If canceled prior to the first 2-year-old payment, the nomination fees will be refunded to the nominators.

Supplemental Nominations:

Three-year-olds not nominated as yearlings and/or sustained as 2-year-olds may become eligible by making the following supplementary nomination payment by February 15, 2019:

Supplemental nominees do not have to pay the normal February 15 sustaining fee, but must still pay the entrance fee if declared to start.
